Environmental Protection Policy

This document sets out the current policy of The Mercedes-Benz Club Limited (we or the Club) in relation to environmental protection matters. We review this document annually and additionally if relevant circumstances change and may update it, in which case we will publish the updated version on our website.

We recognise our responsibilities under applicable law that protects the environment.

Our overall commitment is to:

- comply with relevant environmental legislation, and
- reduce the Club's impact on the environment where practicable.

We actively manage our environmental impact at our offices by:

- making efficient use of water and energy, including through switching non-essential electrical equipment off out of hours
- sourcing more environmentally-friendly replacements for older equipment when it has to be replaced
- minimising our use of paper where possible
- sourcing paper products which are either made from recycled paper or paper from well managed forests, for example FSC certified paper
- using eco-friendly products, such as biodegradable cleaning materials where possible and printer cartridges, and
- recycling our waste.

We actively manage our environmental impact in our other activities by:

- reusing existing materials and equipment where feasible
- providing relevant Officials with spill kits in the event of any spillages of oil or fuel at our events
- reducing the amount of data we hold
- holding management meetings electronically as well as in person, and
- supporting the use of car sharing and public transport for attending management meetings.
